## DANIELLE WINGER (b. 1986, Reno , NV)

Danielle Winger creates luminous landscape paintings that explore the emotional and psychological dimensions of the natural world. Drawing inspiration from the traditions of German Romanticism, she depicts mountains, forests, deserts, and expansive horizons as spaces of contemplation, transformation, and introspection. Through expressive brushwork, heightened color, and atmospheric light, Winger constructs landscapes that move beyond direct observation, inviting viewers into environments shaped as much by memory, feeling, and imagination as by physical geography.

At the heart of Winger's practice is an interest in nature as a mirror for human experience. Her paintings evoke moments of solitude, wonder, and transcendence, suggesting the landscape as a site where inner and outer worlds converge. Balancing gestural energy with quiet reflection, she creates immersive compositions that oscillate between the familiar and the dreamlike. Through this interplay, Winger examines the enduring capacity of landscape painting to communicate emotional states and to foster a deeper sense of connection to both place and self.
